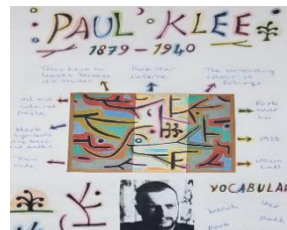

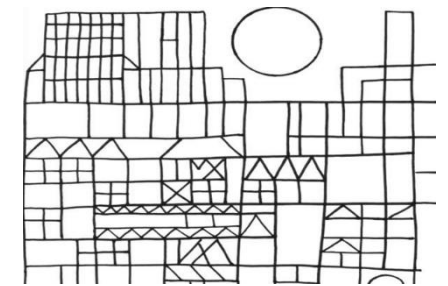
Sketchbook Focus & Key Knowledge
