- 6) I used 8bags of sand for 12m², how much will I need for 15m²?

Research project: this information will be used to inform their writing over the next term

You can present what you find out in any way you like but there are a few key facts that you will need to ensure you find the answers to!

- 1) Find out about the timeline of the life of the Titanic – for instance - the date she set sail, where from, when she first got into difficulty, the time she sank.
- 2) Find out 5 interesting facts about the building of the Titanic. How long was she? What was her top speed? How many decks did she have? etc.
- 3) Find out about some of the facilities that she had on board. See if you can find out some of the differences between the different classes.
- 4) **Research one passenger who was on board.** Make sure you know: their name; which class their ticket was; whether or not they survived and anything else you can about them. (This should not be a crew member.)
- 5) Watch what you can about it but make sure you have checked this with your parents / carers as some of the films are very sad and may contain images that are upsetting. This was a tragedy with a large loss of life so it is a serious topic.
