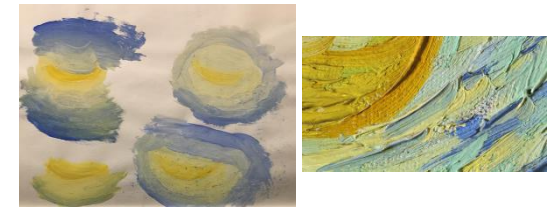
## Sketchbook Focus & Key Knowledge
