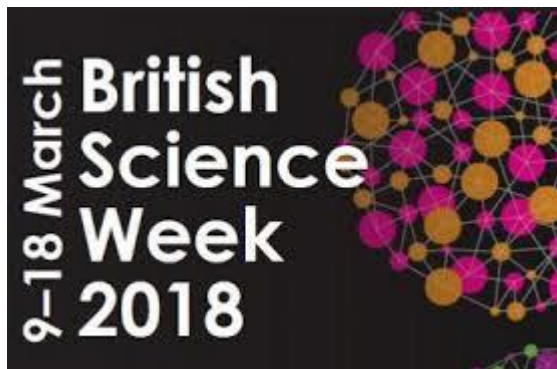

Safety Near Our Crossing Patrols

Poor parking close to the crossing patrols, especially on the corners of rounds is putting children's lives at risk. We are also aware of cars mounting pavements on Love Lane when traffic starts to get grid locked. Can we please emphasise that the more you give your child a chance to walk from a little distanced away from the school, the less the congestion will be a problem.

Crossing Patrol service in Pulens Lane

Jo Hopkins, the School Crossing Patrol Officer on Pulens Lane, Petersfield has resigned and will be leaving at the end of this term. Her last working day will be 29/3/18, therefore there will be no cover from 16 April until further notice.

The Hampshire County Council School Crossing Patrol Service currently has a large team of dedicated community-minded men and women carrying out the important role of ensuring the safety of children on their way to and from school.

We currently have a vacancy on Pulens Lane, Petersfield. We would be keen to hear from parents, grandparents and members of the local community who can demonstrate traffic awareness, a sense of responsibility and are keen to show dedication and commitment in carrying out this important role to make the roads of Hampshire safer for children travelling to and from School.

Experience is not necessary as full training will be provided, more important are your personal qualities and commitment to provide a safe crossing environment for children travelling between home and school during term time. Patrol working hours are up to 1 hour in the morning and up to 1 hour in the afternoon during school term-time. A uniform is provided to protect you against the elements. Starting salary is £8.12 per hour plus a payment in lieu of holidays. The post is subject to an Enhanced DBS check.
