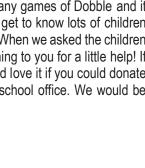

SNACKTOBER (Herne's version of **SNACKTEMBER**)

At Herne we are keen to create a culture where aspects of food and drink in school promote the health and wellbeing of our children. Our current policy is that breaktime snacks should be healthy e.g. a piece of fruit or veg, a piece of cheese or a small cereal bar. Items like chocolate or crisps are not encouraged.

From Monday 6th October, up until October half term we will be focusing on SNACKTOBER. This initiative is about educating and motivating children to think about their snack choices in a healthy way. The aim is to prioritise MORE fruit and vegetables and LESS saturated fats and sugars in food.

We will be running a friendly competition between classes, in each year group for the highest number of healthy snacks brought into school each day (each child will be limited to enter 1 snack per day for the competition).

The children will also receive a bingo card to keep in their tray to increase their motivation for bringing new and exciting healthy snacks – perhaps they could try eating as many different coloured snacks as possible?

If you are stuck for ideas for healthy snack choices, there are some fun recipe videos on Youtube that might help Fruit and oat bites - Snack-tember 2025; Homemade Popcorn - Snack-tember 2025; Paprika Tortilla Chips and Spring Onion Dip - Snack-tember 2025; Beany Dip and Crunchy Veg - Snack-tember 2025; Pizza Muffins - Snack-tember 2025
