



# Today you are going to write a short section of the Mr Wuffles story!





If you have access to the internet, you can watch a quick recap of the story...

As you know, the Mr Wuffles book has no text. So today, you get the chance to become the author of the story! For your Mr Wuffles writing, you are going to focus on these 3 illustrations from the book...



Meanwhile...

Bravely...

With a yowl of frustration...

Feeling utterly confused...

Like a....

I would like you to use each picture to write **3 paragraphs**, to describe the part of the story where the aliens and their insect allies burst out from beneath the radiator to distract Mr Wuffles!

I have put a **useful word bank** on the website to help you with powerful words and spellings. Please take a look at it before you start!

To give you an idea of how to start the first paragraph, here is an example of the story opening. You can use this to get your writing started if you want to, but remember you can edit in your own ideas. Especially the words and phrases in red...

Without warning, the allies **burst out** from beneath the radiator. "Chase me!" yelled Zork, **frantically** waving the flag around over his head. "Over here, **cat-face!**" Zed **taunted**. "**Call yourself a top predator?!**" In shock, Mr Wuffles leapt into the air, hissing and spitting, as...

1. Write a paragraph to go with each picture. Just like my example, each paragraph must have **a mixture of action and speech!**
2. Choose your words and phrases carefully, to try to create a feeling of dramatic action, a sense of danger and a fast pace!
3. Please think carefully about all of your **punctuation!** “ . ! ?” , CAPS
4. Make sure you don't use said and try to use an adverb with each 'said' word. Choose your words to express the alien's feelings!
5. Extra challenge: Use a range of speech sentences which have the name of the speaker at the beginning, in the middle *and* at the end of sentences!
6. **Check and edit your writing.**

\*Aim to work on your writing for at least half an hour.\*
