3. A fruit cake has a mass of 1.5kg. If 40% of the mass is fruit, find the mass of the fruit in grams.
4. The length of a rectangle is 3 times its width. If the perimeter is 192cm, find the length.
5. Now find the width.
6. 90% of £300.

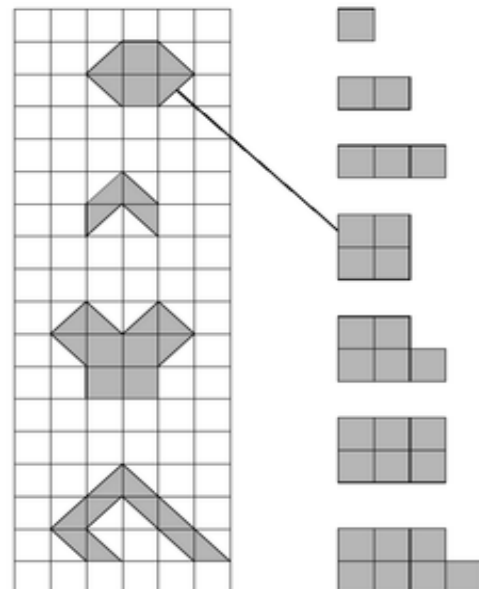
