

CARE OF MAGICAL CREATURES

Today you are going to teach one of the highly acclaimed courses at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry ... Care of Magical Creatures (also known as Creature Care). This is an elective course at Hogwarts that can be chosen by students in their third year so it is essential that your explanations are top notch.

In the class, students learn about a wide range of magical creatures, from flobberworms to fire crabs, and even unicorns and thestrals. Students are taught about feeding, maintaining, breeding, and proper treatment of these creatures and much more.



Care of Magical Creatures classes typically take place outside of Hagrid's Hut, so you will have plenty of space however some lessons occasionally take place in the Forbidden Forest.

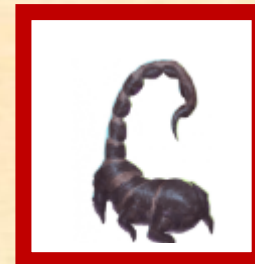
The year group you teach is entirely your choice – you can go from third to sixth years. At the bottom of this notice, you will find a list of the magical creatures each year is expected to become knowledgeable about if they wish to successfully complete this course. You cannot teach an illegal creature (as has been the case with Hagrid in the past) Dumbledore will be watching closely.



You will need to teach your students all about feeding, maintaining, breeding, grooming, exercise, habitat in captivity, and proper treatment of these creatures.



Use your imagination and create a helpful leaflet for your students to take away with them at the end of the lesson to help with their exam revision.



Third Year Hippogriff, Flobberworm, Salamander.

Fourth Year Fire Crabazle, Murtlap, Niffler, Streeler, Unicorn.

Fifth Year Bowtruckle, Thestral, Knarl, Kneazle, Chimaera, Crup, Porlock, Fairy, Puffskein, Flobberworm.

Sixth Year Glumbumble, Diricawl, Fwooper, Moke, Jackalope.
