



Year 4 Homework Instructions –
Weekly homework sheets DO NOT need to be stuck in.

Maths: Fun Five! Answers in book please.



Each week the children will receive 5 maths questions. It is their choice as to whether they do the  or  depending on how hard they find them.

They are required to answer these in their homework book.

Quick Comprehension: Every week the children will receive a short extract to read with a small selection of questions. This will be on the reverse of this sheet. Children should allow themselves one minute to read the text, and five/ten minutes to answer the questions. Some of the questions are quite tricky, so don't worry if they have to talk them through with an adult. The questions should be recorded in their homework book (**not on the sheet.**) If children really struggle with writing, we are allowing parents to scribe this for them.

Spellings

Core

Support

The spellings are split into Core and Support, and children will know which list they should focus on.

This year we would like the children to take ownership of learning their spellings so we do not need to see **written** evidence of this in their homework book.

We have bought into Spelling Shed and every child will have a log in (see home link book.) On this website, they will find that their spelling lists are already set up as 'Assignments'. Children then access their list and will have to learn the spellings through games and activities, they can also test themselves in order to check they know them. When they have learnt these spellings the programme opens up for them to focus on more spellings covered in the curriculum. There is an app that you can download if you wish, however this does have a small charge. The Year 4 team will be checking that children are learning their spellings on a weekly basis. Please bear with us, as this is a new programme to us as well.

SPaG Challenge

Each week there will be a short Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar question (SPaG) for the children to copy and complete in their homework books.

Times Tables

Children are required to know all of the times tables up to 12 x 12 and quickly recall them by heart.

Our expectation is that children will aim to use TT Rock Stars 5 times a week, both Garage /Gig and Studio mode. This will be checked by the teacher to monitor the children's progress.

At present, children will keep their times tables homework books at school. They will also have access to tables training grids and wheels in class. These grids are also available on our Year 4 homework page on the website for you to print out at home. Remember you can use Doodle Maths, Doodle Times Tables and other apps.

Homework will be given out on a Friday and is due in on the following Friday. If children do not have their homework in school to mark on that day, they will do their homework in values time that afternoon.
