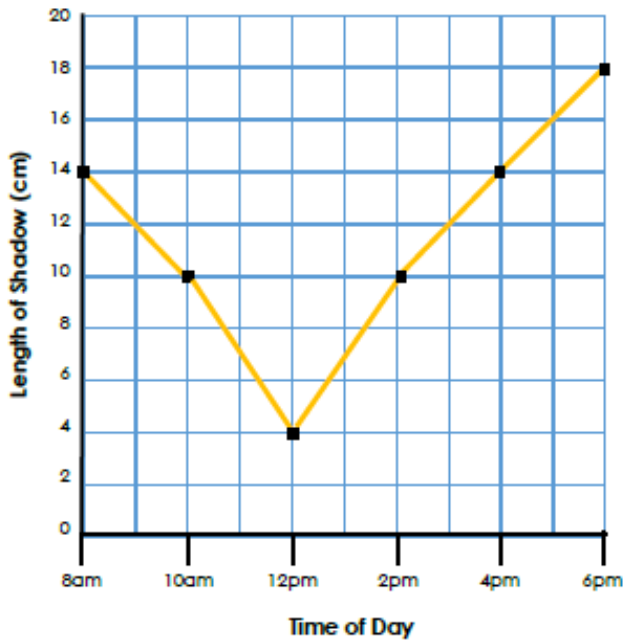


Year 4 Homework, Summer Term 1 Week 8 Support

4. What is the difference in length between the shortest and longest shadow?
5. Why do you think the shadow was shortest at 12pm?
