- Children need to have appropriate clothes for Forest School. (Waterproofs, coats, waterproof wellies/ boots)


Homework- Reading at home

- "Reading is the key." Daily Reading is 10-15 minutes, 5x a week minimum. Daily Reading will be monitored through the signed Home-link books.
- We recommend that the children read their school colour banded link book but you may wish to intersperse this with other books too. Every child may borrow up to 2 books from the link and 2 from the Library. Unless they are a free reader then they can have 3.
- The Library and Link are open after school everyday 3.30-4.00pm for you to visit with your child.
- Use questions from link books to support your child with comprehension as this is a vital part of their reading development.
- Our website also has suggestions and support.

Homework – Spellings and Tables

- Weekly spellings Will be given out on a Friday. There will be a weekly spelling test (usually Friday). We will only ask for evidence of spelling homework if a child's test scores become a concern.
- Times Tables- If your child is assessed as being very competent in this area, they will be asked to continue practising their times tables in a way that suits them. They will be tested weekly. This is to ensure that their rapid recall of the facts remains. If we feel that your child needs to continue to have targeted practice, then they will be given a weekly times table to learn. This will be on the weekly homework sheet. They will also receive a times table book that they must complete **daily** and return to school to be checked on a **Friday**. They will also be tested weekly.
