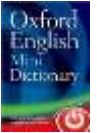


Nut free school

BACK TO SCHOOL WITH DOODLE

Over 60% of pupils who achieve a 7-day streak in Doodle go on to achieve a 14-day streak – and if children use Doodle for 10 minutes a day for 30 days, that's an additional five hours of learning each month! We still have some Doodle licences to purchase, both computer programs/apps are usually £55 each per year (£110), but we can sell you both products for just £12, saving you £98!
