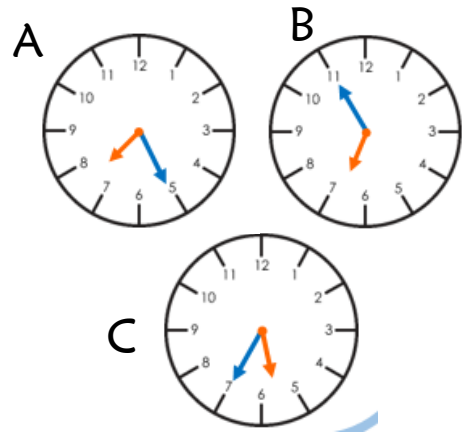

Echolocation

- 8 Submarines and ships use sonar technology to navigate
- 18 the depths of the oceans. However, did you know that
- 26 many animals are born with a similar ability?
- 34 Echolocation is nature's own built-in sonar system and
- 43 is used by many species to gather information about
- 52 where objects are in a space. These creatures produce
- 60 sound waves which bounce off other objects before
- 69 hitting their ears. Using these echoes, they can then
- 78 work out where something is without having to use
- 80 their sight.
- 89 Bats use echolocation to great effect when trying to
- 99 locate insect prey in the dark and dolphins, whales and
- 109 many birds also have a similar skill. Some blind people
- 117 have also been known to develop echolocation abilities!
