Children's Charity Events

Thank you so much to Miss Hall, Miss Cameron and our lovely allotment children who had a plant sale last Friday selling the crops they have managed to grow in our school allotment. They raised an incredible £207, which will be added to the Ukraine Refugee collection and forwarded to the Disasters Emergency Committee after half-term.



We are also looking forward to a second book sale by our Year 4 children, Pixie, Issy and Pippa, **this coming Thursday at 3.30pm**. All money raised will be donated to the Bloodrunners, known as SERV Wessex. They are motorcycle riders (Service by Emergency Rider Volunteers) who support the Air Ambulance every single day and deliver blood products, medication, heart monitors and neo-natal expressed baby milk 365 days of the year, often overnight.
