Gold Mark in School Games

The school is a part of the Havant Area for the School Games initiative. The school enters a vast array of Level 2 sports competitions, encouraging participation for all. This includes Girls/Boys Football, Tag-Rugby, Table Tennis, Badminton, Tennis, Athletics and Swimming.

Special Focused Weeks
